For your reference, NI Water is not subject to the Water Industry Act 1991. Our duties are listed in the Water & Sewerage Services (NI) Order 2006. That legislation lays out for us the information about our Trade Effluent customers that we are required to make publicly available

This Article also places a duty on NI Water to keep the Registers available for public inspection at our office at all times. While this is the case, we acknowledge that attending our offices may not be possible for all interested parties.

As such, I have attached a spreadsheet with the information that you have requested. This includes most of the information that you have requested. It does not identify the point of connection to the receiving sewer, as this is on the consents for each customer, which are too numerous to provide via email, but the receiving Wastewater Treatment Works is detailed on the spreadsheet. In terms of "Nature of the consented discharge / process description", there is a high-level Industry type column. More details are included on the consents themselves.

The consents are available to view via the Company's Extranet where consents listed alphabetically and relevant records can only readily be located where the customer name is known, or by reviewing entries individually. If you would like to view the full register of consents, please complete and return the attached Extranet Licence Agreement. I have included the Terms of Use for your reference.
