NI Water is responsible for delivering water and wastewater services to approximately

800,000

homes and businesses across the whole of Northern Ireland.



The Government has officially designated NI Water's workforce necessary to deliver water and wastewater services as 'key workers' in a critical public service.

This means that NI Water staff and various support teams have never been more essential to the health and wellbeing of our customers than now, and we would ask the public to be supportive of our workers during this difficult time

Every day, NI Water and our support teams - such as contractors, site supervisors and maintenance personnel - work tirelessly to ensure:

- that water supply interruptions are avoided or minimised;
- that faults in the network are fixed as quickly as possible, and;
- that our facilities are maintained, upgraded and replaced as required to provide this vital service for the public.

These measures are necessary to ensure that drinking water is treated and supplied to customers and that wastewater is collected, treated and returned safely to the environment.






With a piped network of over 42,000km and over 2,000 water and wastewater installations across Northern Ireland, we are proud of the vital work that our staff and contracting teams carry out to keep water and wastewater services flowing in the communities they serve.

If you see our teams out working, please be assured that they are there to ensure we can meet your water and wastewater needs. We are all practising social distancing – our priority is to keep customers and colleagues safe. To help us do this, please keep a minimum of 2m distance from our workers while they carry out essential work in your area.

A few key points to remember:

- If we need to visit your home during this time, to keep you and us safe, please make our staff aware if you are self-isolating. We will also ask you to respect social distancing for our colleagues if they are on your property.
- Remember wipes will clog the sewers and result in blockages and flooding - never flush a wipe.

- Beware of Bogus Callers if you are concerned about the identity of someone at your door, you can call the PSNI non-emergency number '101' where you will have the option of a 'Quickcheck' to confirm the caller is from the utility they say they are.
