

Lead Pipe Replacement Application

Under the Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations (NI) 2007 (SR 147) and amendments

This form can be used to apply for the replacement of an existing lead pipe for separately occupied units or properties situated on the same development, road or street, placing a similar demand/supply requirement on our water network.

The replacement connection must be at the same location as the existing supply, if not, there may be a charge for this service.

Please ensure completion of all sections, as any missing information may result in the delay/return of your application. Please refer to our guidance notes before completing your application.

Please note

You need to carry out the following work at your own expense:

- lay a new service pipe to the boundary of your property
- > Carry out any necessary internal plumbing work.

NIW will carry out the necessary work from the boundary of the property to the watermain in the footpath/road. Under no circumstances will NIW or contractor(s) working on their behalf, carry out work within private property. Lead pipe replacement is free of charge on a like for like basis only.
