Key Stage Two 'Every Drop Counts' Poster Competition

We wish to invite your school to participate in Northern Ireland Water's (NI Water) Annual Schools Competition.

In Northern Ireland each person uses on average 153 litres of water a day, much of which is wasted. The competition will focus on designing a poster to remind of the importance of saving water and the little things they can every day to make sure every drops counts.

The competition is open to KS2 pupils in all primary schools in Northern Ireland, with a category for Special Needs Schools.

Prize money for the winning schools:Primary schools in each age category, P5, P6 and P7
First prize- £250, Second prize- £150, Third place- £100
Special Needs category:

First prize- £250, Second prize- £150, Third place- £100

Each winning pupil will receive a "goody bag" and certificate and will be invited to an awards ceremony at NI Water's Wastewater Heritage Centre, Belfast in June 2018.
